WHAT IS A FAMILY TEAM CONFERENCE?

A Family Team Conference is a gathering of family members, friends, and others who care about the well-being of a child or children in a family.

The purpose of a Family Team Conference is to empower families & ensure the safety of children in a particular home.

WHY WOULD A FAMILY TEAM CONFERENCE BE HELD?

Almost any family situation could benefit from a Family Team Conference.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES OF FAMILY TEAM CONFERENCING

Families are experts regarding their own lives.

Families can and do come up with the best solutions for their particular needs.

All families have strengths.

It is important to focus on solutions, rather than problems.

Flexibility: Services and solutions are matched to the unique needs of the individual family.

WHO PARTICIPATES?

Anyone who the family invites may participate.

PARTICIPANTS MAY INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- Birth parents
- Child
- Siblings, if age-appropriate
- Extended family
- Friends
- Neighbors
- School representatives
- Church pastors, members, etc.
- Current case manager and/or child protective investigator(s)
- Representatives from community service organizations
- Guardian ad Litem(s)
- A community facilitator who is trained to facilitate these meetings
